Occupational Therapy Australia Research Awards



History

These awards were established to recognise occupational therapists undertaking research and contributing to the evidence base of occupational therapy.

Frequency

The Awards are available on a biennial basis.

Eligibility and Selection Criteria

- Applicants must be an occupational therapist who has completed research into aspect of
 occupational therapy practice, or research into issues relevant to occupational therapy, that
 has been published in the past two years.
- Applicants must be a member of Occupational Therapy Australia for at least the last five continuous years (unless a student, where membership of OTA can be a year).
- Applicants must be a resident of Australia.
- For the Category 4 Research Team Award, the majority of OTs within the research team must be members of OTA.

Category 1 - Early Career Researcher

Research conducted by an occupational therapist prior to completion of their PhD or up to a maximum of four years' academic research experience following the completion of their PhD, or be of equivalent professional standing.

Category 2 - Mid Career Researcher

This category refers to research conducted by an occupational therapist 5-10 years from the award of their PhD or with equivalent professional standing.

Category 3 - Clinical Researcher

This category refers to research undertaken by an occupational therapist, who holds a substantive clinical position.

Category 4 – Research Team

This category refers to research undertaken by a team where the lead investigator is an occupational therapist leading the team, or a team of occupational therapists, who have completed research into an aspect of occupational therapy practice or issue relevant to occupational therapy that has been published in the past two years.

Applications will be considered against the following with consideration to the relevance of the criteria for each of the categories:

- Contribution to occupational therapy practice and knowledge
- Number of published articles and range of journals published in (including international journals)
- Number of conference presentations and range of conferences presented at (including international conferences)
- Mentoring and supervision of other occupational therapy researchers
- International research collaboration

Application Process

- Will be electronic.
- · Applications must include the following:
 - A resume of the applicant(s);
 - A statement addressing the criteria that the applications will be considered against;
 - Two written references;
 - Between 1 and 3 articles published in the past three years demonstrating the area of research being presented;
 - o A 400-500 word biography; and
 - A high-resolution photo.

Selection Panel:

Will consist of three members of the Occupational Therapy Australia Research Academy.
